Journey for Sight: 40 Years on the Trail

What began in Birtle, Manitoba, in 1983 as a one-sled-one-rider pledge campaign has grown into a powerful movement. Each winter, dedicated snowmobile riders from



Northern, Central, and Southern Manitoba, and now Northwestern Ontario, brave the elements to raise funds and awareness through one of our most iconic fundraising efforts: **Journey for Sight**.

Over the course of a week, riders travel more than 200 kilometres, stopping in rural communities to collect pledges before gathering in Brandon for a final celebration and cheque presentation.

But this ride isn't just about the journey. It's about what those pledges make possible.

Funds raised through Journey for Sight help support the Foundation's programs, like:

- Giving Glances and KidSight, offering early vision screening for children
- Simply Sound, connecting people with hearing loss to the support they need
- Helping Hands, which provides financial assistance to people in need
- Serenity Suites, offering a home away from home



Since 1983, the event has raised nearly \$2.5 million. It's a true testament to the determination of our riders, the generosity of donors, and the deep-rooted spirit of service that fuels our Lions Clubs.

This past winter, just 11 riders raised an incredible \$51,000+ on the trail from Dauphin to Brandon.

And now, the road to the 40th Anniversary Ride has officially begun. On June 1, riders and Lions gathered in Dauphin to kick off the planning for this exciting milestone.

KidSight: A Clear Mission with a Growing Impact

Vision is one of the most essential tools in a child's development, and thanks to KidSight, more families than ever are getting the early answers they need.



This June, our hands-free vision screening program proved once again just how vital and in-demand it is. Across Manitoba and Northwestern Ontario, Lions Clubs and volunteers brought KidSight into the heart of local communities. From daycares to school gyms and community festivals, screenings happened where families naturally gather.



One shining example?

The Summer in the City Festival in Steinbach, where nearly 300 children were screened over just two days. Out of those, 43 were referred for follow-up care.

Many of these kids are under six years old, when early intervention can make all the difference. Events like this demonstrate not only a strong turnout but also reveal a real need. And they're not the only ones.

And this is just one snapshot. Across the region, countless Lions volunteers dedicated their time, energy, and heart to bringing KidSight to their communities this June. Thanks to their care, hundreds of children now have a brighter, clearer path ahead.

To every volunteer who helped make this possible, we are endlessly grateful. Your kindness, commitment, and belief in early care are what make this work shine. Without you, none of this would be possible.

They keep children warm through long nights, allow parents to cook nourishing meals, and offer a sense of stability during uncertain times.
