1. Eligibility

- Ticket purchasers and prize winners must be at least 18 years of age.

2. Tickets

- Tickets will be sold in person only, using printed paper tickets.
- All ticket sales will close on Saturday, February 7, 2026, at 11:59 PM. No tickets will be sold after this date and time.
- Tickets are non-refundable and hold no cash value beyond their eligibility for the raffle prize.

3. Draw Information

- The draw will take place on Sunday, February 8, 2026, at 1 P.M., at Smitty's Restaurant at 1601 Main Street, Dauphin, MB, R7N 3J5.
- The winning ticket will be drawn manually from a draw drum containing all eligible ticket stubs.
- The draw will be conducted publicly, and the winning number will be announced at the event.
- The winning ticket number will also be posted on the Lions Foundation website and/or social media channels.

4. Prize

- One cash prize consisting of 50% of total ticket sales.
- The final prize value depends on the number of tickets sold, with a maximum possible prize of \$12,500 (based on total sales of 5,000 tickets at \$5 each).

5. Restrictions and Claiming the Prize

- To claim the prize, the winner must present the original winning ticket and valid government-issued identification.

Funds may be used for purchasing equipment, program delivery, and other project-related expenses that ensure the successful delivery and sustainability of these programs.
