It's a reunion. A promise.


A tradition carried through four decades of early mornings, frozen fingers, deep snow, shared laughter, and the deep satisfaction of helping people right here at home.



Forty years ago, a small group of Lions saw a growing need in their communities: families struggling with vision loss, children missing out on early detection, and individuals unable to access the care they needed.

They didn't have a fundraising plan, a roadmap, or even perfect weather. But they had determination.

So they started a ride. A simple winter journey from one community to the next, collecting donations along the trail.

The team still showed up, proving that the Journey isn't defined by the weather, but by the commitment behind it.



WHY WE RIDE

The Journey for Sight has always been about helping neighbours. The funds raised support Manitobans who need vision and hearing care, families travelling for medical treatment, children who deserve early screening, and individuals striving to live with dignity and independence.

Funds raised through Journey for Sight power the Lions Foundation's programs:



Giving Glances – Free vision screenings for children through the KidSight program, eyeglass recycling and support for people with vision impairment



Simply Sound – Free hearing screenings for kids and assistance for those with hearing issues



Helping Hands – Assistance for families and individuals with medical expenses and supports not covered by healthcare



Serenity Suites – affordable accommodations for individuals and families travelling to Winnipeg for medical treatment.

Since its beginning, the Journey for Sight has raised over \$2.5 million for charitable initiatives.

This incredible impact is made possible by the dedication of riders, the generosity of donors, and the fantastic support of Lions Clubs across our region.

Forty days from now, riders from across the province will once again leave from the North, South, and West — travelling more than 1,000 kilometres before meeting in Brandon.
